The Contest

Teens will perform an original skit, song, or poem approximately 3-5 minutes long that promotes smart driving for teens. A prize will be awarded to the top three winners. The contest will be held on Friday, June 12th, 6-9pm in Selden. *There will be a mandatory performance rehearsal on June 9th, 3-9 pm, in Selden.*

Rules of the Contest

**Please
Read**

Teens **must attend** the *Teen Driver Safety Awareness Workshop* on Wednesday, April 29th, 7-9pm, in Selden to be eligible to participate in the contest. At least one person per group must attend, but it is recommended that all participants attend.

The commercial has to be related to a teen driving issue and should be 3-5 minutes in length. Teens between 6th-12th grade can participate.

Performances must include "Allstate" in their skit, song, or poem at least one time.

Performers and groups must hand in the name of the group (if applicable) with a complete set of lyrics and/or script of the commercial on the date of the performance rehearsal by May 29th at any reference desk in Centereach or Selden.

The order of the performances will be decided at the performance rehearsal by a lottery system.

Performers and groups are responsible for any props or musical instruments used in the commercial. The Library will not be responsible for any missing equipment.

The contest will be judged on these three criteria:

- Relevance to teen driving issues
- Performance
- Originality

The judges will select one winner with two runner-ups. All decisions are final.

Groups must notify us to any member changes at least three days prior to the event.

The application is due by May 4th. They can be returned to any reference desk in Centereach or Selden.

*Please note that fighting, cursing, or using obscene language or gestures will not be allowed.
Alcohol and drug use in any form is prohibited.*

Anyone violating these terms will be removed from the competition and the premises.

The Contest Timeline



April 29th, 7-9pm, Selden: *Teen Driver Safety Awareness Workshop*– attendance is **MANDATORY** to participate in the *Show Off For Safety Contest*.



May 4th: Application packets are due. Can be handed in at any reference desk in Centereach or Selden.



May 29th: Groups and performers **must** submit complete lyrics and/or scripts of the skits to be performed. Can be handed in at any reference desk in Centereach or Selden.



June 9th, 3pm-9pm, Selden: *Mandatory Performance Rehearsal*. Groups and performers must attend this rehearsal. Performance order will be assigned at this meeting.



June 12th, 10am-2pm, Selden: *Rehearsal and media greeting*. Groups or performers who are available and interested in doing a second rehearsal and media opportunity will meet at this time. Attendance is not required.



June 12th, 6-9pm, Selden: *Show Off For Safety Contest*. The final night of the contest! The top three performers will be awarded their prizes. **Friends and Family are Welcome!!!**
